After a busy day, Jesus and his disciples set out to cross the Sea of Galilee. They anticipated a leisurely evening on the water. Jesus even found a pillow and went to sleep.

Unexpectedly a **great windstorm arose, and the waves beat into the boat, so that it was already filling**. You can imagine the frantic scene. Of the 12 men, some were trying to control the boat, others were bailing the water, others were hanging on for dear life, and all of them were afraid.

They woke Jesus not to calm the storm, but to join in their agitated hectic attempt at survival. Their question was an accusation: **Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?**

At times, Jesus wants to see if our faith means anything. He asks, **"Why are you so fearful? How is it that you have no faith?"** Jesus reveals that the opposite of faith is fear. Faith should be revealed in the storms of life, but often in fear we ask "Does God care?"

At times we wonder, "Where is God?" "What is He doing?" and "Why He is letting this happen?" When we pray, we expect Him to be embroiled with us in the battle for survival. We forget that Christ is in our "boat," and that His Father is over the storm. He still commands that we **be still, and know that I am God**. (Psalms 46:10) As the song says, *The God on the mountain, is still God in the valley/When things go wrong, He'll make them right/And the God of the good times, is still God in the bad times/The God of the day is still God in the night.*
