Abraham thought, surely the fear of God is not in this place; and they will kill me, so, he tells Abimelech that Sarah is his sister, allowing Abimelech to take her into his harem. Abraham's goal was to protect his own life and property. It seems Sarah's pain and humiliation, or what his life would be like without her, did not matter. I wonder, did he even have a plan to rescue her?

God intervenes in the fiasco with a clear directive to Abimelech: **Restore the man's wife**; for he is a prophet, and he will pray for you and you shall live. But if you do not restore her, know that you shall surely die, you and all who are yours.

Abimelech called Abraham and said to him, "What have you done to us? How have I offended you, that you have brought on me and on my kingdom a great sin? ... What did you have in view, that you have done this thing?" (Genesis 20:7-11)

What is in our view? Are we convinced that truth and right cannot stand before godlessness and sin? Are we any better than Abraham when we hide our relationship to Jesus, do not explain our Scriptural worldview, or are silent when persons actively sin in our presence? Are we more concerned with our well-being than the sinner's condemnation?

God would prefer we take the role of an ambassador. We are to **go therefore and make disciples of all the nations,** and **pray for those who spitefully use** us, so **that the wicked** will **turn from his way and live.** (Matthew 28:19a, Luke 6:28b, Ezekiel 33:11b)
