Greetings to all my Friends,

Joshua was surveying Jericho when he met a man with a drawn sword. He asks the man, "Are You for us or for our adversaries?" So He said, "No, but as Commander of the army of the Lord I have now come." (Joshua 5:13-14a). The fact that the Commander of the Lord's Army is not for Israel nor for their enemy indicates once again, that God loves all people, and makes His sun rise on the evil and on the good (Matthew 5:45b).

When God told Abraham his children would be enslaved in Egypt for four generations the reason was because the iniquity of the Amorites is not yet complete (Genesis 15:16b). Some four hundred years later, when the Commander of the Lord's army showed Himself to Joshua, He had determined the Amorite iniquity was complete, needing to be atoned for or judged.

The old things of the Amorites had to pass away so that the Israelites could experience a new life. Israel's entrance into the promised land was like us experiencing new life in Jesus Christ. Thankfully, our sins were atoned for when Jesus took our sins into Himself on the Cross, and we did not have to die. Yet when Jesus became the propitiation for our sin the old things of our life had to be destroyed. Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new (2 Corinthians 5:17); knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin (Romans 6:6).

As Lent begins, let's remind ourselves that God is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance (2 Peter 3:9b).
