Greetings to all my Friends,

My son recently gave up the "American dream" to be a missionary in Kenya. He sold his thriving cabinet business, rented out his house, sold his vehicle, and moved his family of four children to Nakuru. As a father, the one side of my heart is bursting with joy that he was willing to walk away from "success" to serve the Lord. The other side doesn't want him or his family to suffer. I wonder what hardships they will encounter.

There is another Father who must have had similar feelings when His Son gave up the glory they shared (John 17:5b, see Matthew 3:17, and 17:5), and made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men (Philippians 2:7b.)

Before He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross (Philippians 2:8b) Jesus showed His Father to the world (John 14:7-9). He sought and saved that which was lost (Luke 19:10). Ultimantly He brought many sons to glory (Hebrews 2:10).

The Father could have granted Jesus' prayer request to take this cup from Him (Luke 22:42a). Instead He let His Son suffer what He had sent His Son to do. Jesus could have also called for twelve legions of angels (Matthew 26:53b), but He went through the humiliation so he could be the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame (Hebrews 12:2a).

This Resurrection Sunday let's remember Jesus has sat down [again] at the right hand of the throne of God (Hebrews 12:2b) in His glory and each of us still have the responsibility to "go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature" (Mark 16:15b).

6 PRAISE that the Twelve:24 Capital Campaign is being supported and funds are coming in to buy a second web press and a fourth bindery. (Pray for the 9 million people world wide that speak Hebrew — mainly living in Israel).

(Pray for the Herero speaking peoples living in Namibia and Botswana.)

10 Pray for the <u>Prayer at the Press</u> event this evening focusing on the spiritual and physical needs of Israel.

righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom."
—Hebrews 1:8

- 11 Praise the Lord for containers that arrived safely in Nigeria, Niger, Eswatini, Malawi, Costa Rica, Brazil, and Sierra Leone. (Pray for the 50,000 Hmong Daw speakers living in parts of China, Laos, Thailand, and Vietnam.)

 "The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever!"—Revelation 11:15b
- 12 PRAY for those observing the Passover starting at sundown. May they recognize their long awaited Messiah in Jesus. (Pray for the 13 million people who speak Hungarian in Hungary, Romania, Slovakia, and Serbia.)

 Jesus Christ, who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, angels and authorities and powers having been made subject to Him. —1 Peter 3:21b-22

13 Jesus claimed His Kingship by riding into Jerusalem on a donkey. PRAY for His coming return as King of kings and Lord of lords. (Pray for the Ibaloi speaking people living in the Philippines.)

And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth." —Matthew 28:18

14 PRAY for our distributors in Goma, DRC living amidst civil war and food shortages. (*Pray for the 500,000 Ibanag speaking people, living in the Philippines.*)

"Father, the hour has come. Glorify Your Son, that Your Son also may glorify You, as You have given Him authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to as many as You have given Him." –John 17:1b-2

15 PRAY for the scheduling and plate making skills of our Prepress Department, which includes Twila, Trent, Beth, and Steve W. (Pray for the speakers of Ibo living chiefly in Southeastern Nigeria.)

Grace to you and peace from God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ, who gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father. —Galatians 1:3-4

16 PRAY for churches and organizations in Nicaragua that are being closed down by the government.

(Pray for the 313,000 Icelandic speaking people.)

(Igede is a language spoken by the Igede people in Nigeria. Pray for their salvation.)

(Pray for the 7 million people in the Philippines who speak llocano.)

21 PRAY that the 21,000 Yagaria speakers living in Papua New Guinea will discover Help from Above through WMP booklets.

22 PRAY for grace, wisdom, and discernment for Darryl Ramey, our President.
